

ROOKIE CHAMPIONSHIP (CLASS 4)

This is now open to machines under 600cc from classes 2, 3 and 5, but is not compulsory for any rider. You may feel that you would have a better chance competing in one of the other classes, the choice is entirely up to you. For newcomers to the sport, this class is probably a good idea because most riders should be of a similar ability.

SIDECAR CHAMPIONSHIPS

As our support over the past few seasons has been almost entirely from F2 crews, class 11 for F2 600cc sidecars will continue to be our main Championship class. However, class 12 Sidecar Formula 'Owt Else (a good Yorkshire name) will create opportunities for Northern based F1 and Classic racers to have extra outings in their own 'back yards'. Although we don't envisage this as a full championship class, we intend to allocate points in the usual way and, if the support is encouraging, we could make awards at the end of the season to the top 3 crews. Any F350 or Post Classic racers who compete in non-FSRA rounds will also keep their points from their own Championship races.

THE 2011 ROAD & TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP

The meetings at Cadwell Park and Mallory Park also include rounds of our **ROAD & TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP** which is staged over 9 rounds, the other rounds being on the pure 'roads' circuit at Oliver's Mount, Scarborough. An ideal opportunity for riders planning to venture across to the Manx Grand Prix, the TT, or Irish road circuits. The classes in this championship are Solos; Class 2, Class 3, Class 6, Class 8 and Class 10 and for Sidecars Class 11. Entry forms for the Scarborough meetings which are open to National license holders only are available from the Auto 66 office.

SUPER JUNIOR 125cc CUP

This will be run at Cadwell and Mallory meetings in conjunction with event 1. Points for the cup will only be awarded to competitors 21 years and under as at 1/1/2011. The best result of races 2 & 3 to count at each meeting. Trophies and cash awards (1st £100, 2nd £75 & 3rd £50) will be presented to the first three at the end of the series.

COUNT OF CADWELL SOLOS AND SIDECARS

This year's solo championship is for allcomers 175-1300cc (class 10) and points are scored on the third race only at each meeting. The sidecar championship is open to sidecars of any capacity (classes 11 or 12) and again points are scored only on the third race. Trophies and cash awards (1st £250, 2nd £150 & 3rd £100) will be presented to the first three in each class at the end of the series.

EARL OF ELVINGTON SOLO CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship is for allcomers 175-1300cc (class 10) and points are scored on the third race only at each meeting. Trophies and cash awards (1st £250, 2nd £150 & 3rd £100) will be presented to the first three in this class at the end of the series.
